Categories and Classes

Category – Adult

- Class 1: Painting – Acrylic/Oil/Watercolour.
- Class 2: Dry Media – Charcoal/Pastel/Pencil/ Any other drawing medium.
- Class 3: Open – any other medium not listed above, including mixed media.

Category – Youth under 16 years of age

- Class 4: Open – Any medium.

Prizes

Class 1: Winner \$500.00, Runner Up \$100.00 value.

Class 2: Winner \$500.00, Runner Up \$100.00 value.

Class 3: Winner \$500.00, Runner Up \$100.00 value.

Class 4: Winner \$150.00, Runner Up \$50.00 value.

People's Choice: \$300.00

People's Choice Award

All entries will be eligible for a people's choice award and entered automatically. Votes for People's Choice will be collected throughout the exhibition day, and winners will be announced on social media after the conclusion of the Cuby GrooveFest Festival.



Conditions of Entry

- Entries limited to: ADULTS - four per person and four maximum per class. Diptychs and triptychs to be entered as one piece. YOUTH - one per person. **NOTE: All entries can be made available for sale (see below) but only one piece can be awarded per category.**
- Entry forms can be completed and submitted online or paper copies are available to collect or download and return with artwork.
- Entry fees are payable by cash, eftpos or direct deposit (see below).
- Works to be no more than 20kgs in weight and no more than 1.5m X 1.5m in size (including frames).
- Artworks to be clearly marked on the back/base with name and title.
- Each entry shall be the original work of the artist and not copied in full or part from any production or published article.
- Works are not to have been displayed in the Upper Great Southern region in the past 12 months.
- The judges and organising committee reserve the right to reject any entry on the grounds that the material, subject, method, production or standard are considered unsuitable for the purpose of the exhibition.
- Insurance and any other considerations are the responsibility of the artist during the exhibition and transport of the work.
- All pieces must be suitably wrapped and boxed where possible for transport and delivery.
- Works may be available for sale at the exhibition. A commission of 10% will be charged on any artwork sold at the exhibition with all proceeds donated to the Cuballing Fire Brigade.
- Cuby GrooveFest and the Shire of Cuballing takes no responsibility for any delivery or collection costs incurred.
- Cuby GrooveFest and the Shire of Cuballing takes no responsibility for any damage incurred to works from delivery to exhibition to collection.
- All entrants agree that their works will be catalogued digitally and be used in the Shire of Cuballing marketing.
- Late entries will not be accepted.



Delivery and Collection

Delivering your completed artwork

- Complete and submit an Exhibition entry form with your finished artwork/s by 4pm, Tuesday 10th September 2024.
- You may utilise one entry form or multiple forms if you require space.
- Deliver the finished artwork to Julie Christensen at Shire of Cuballing, 186 Campbell St, Cuballing WA 6311 by 4pm, Tuesday 10th September 2024.
- Entry fees are payable as cash or eftpos on delivery of the works or credit card over the phone (08) 9883 6031.
- Artwork must be dry. Wet Artwork will not be accepted.
- Exhibits can be collected from the Cuballing Agricultural Hall, Campbell Street Cuballing on Saturday 14th September between 3–4pm, Sunday 15th September between 11–12.30pm, Monday 16th September between 10am – 4pm, or by prior arrangement with Julie Christensen on (08) 98836031
